Elizabeth (Beezer) Clarkson is a Director at Draper Fisher Juvetson. She manages the DFJ Global Network, which consists of 16 venture funds around the world representing some \$7B of capital under management and over 400 active portfolio companies. Beezer currently serves on the board of ShareThis as well as the Investment committees of DFJ Vina Capital (Vietnam focused venture fund) and DFJ JAIC (cross border US-Japan venture fund).

Beezer began her investment career 17 years ago in Morgan Stanley's Global Infrastructure Group. Most recently she was an Investment Manager at Omidyar Network where she focused on investments in financial services and technology sectors in emerging markets. Her investments included for-profit direct investments, fund investments and non-profit grants. Previously at Hewlett Packard (HP), Beezer led business development negotiations with leading Internet services companies for placement on desktop and notebooks world-wide.

Beezer has a BA in Government from Wesleyan University and an MBA from Harvard Business School. She currently serves on the Board of Trustees for Wesleyan University, the Advisory Board of InVenture and the Investor Advisory Council of Astla.
